## 2020-2021 COURSE SELECTION

### STUDENTS ENTERING 9<sup>th</sup> THROUGH 12<sup>th</sup> GRADES

Each school year, 7th through 11th grade students are required to make their course selections for the following school year. They also must select whether they want to be placed in a Faith West Advanced Placement (FAP), Advanced Placement (AP), College Prep (CP), or Dual Credit (DC) version of their core classes. Mrs. Derry will review all FAP, AP, and DC placement requests.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>FWA uses a block schedule with a two day rotation cycle. Each day contains three periods for core classes, two periods for electives, and one period for a guided study.</li> <li>Each student must select Bible along with one selection in each of the four core class categories. Juniors and Seniors also may select a computer science course if the corequisite is met.</li> <li>You may select two electives each year. Students should make three selections in the event one of the selections is full. Indicate with numbers 1, 2, and 3 for your first, second, and third choices. Classes enroll on a first come, first served basis, so return this selection sheet with parent signature as soon as possible.</li> <li>SAT Prep is most beneficial when taken as a Junior.</li> </ul>	<p><b>COURSE SELECTION NOTES</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Juniors may not take Physics AP and Chemistry AP at the same time.</li> <li>2. If this is your first time to participate in the FW band, you must meet with the Band Director.</li> <li>3. PALS requires an application and acceptance.</li> <li>4. One semester course for .5 credit.</li> <li>5. Studio Art AP has a prerequisite of HS Art 1.</li> <li>6. Computer Science AP has a corequisite of Pre-Calculus or higher. Online only.</li> <li>7. An additional fee is charged for this classes.</li> <li>8. Dual credit courses have an additional fee and require application with the accrediting college.</li> <li>9. Prerequisites are AFNR and one additional AG credit.</li> <li>10. Beginning Fall 2020, the title of ‘Pre-Advanced Placement’ (PAP) courses will change to Faith West Advanced Program (FAP).” For example, if a class was previously called, 'Geometry PAP,' it will now be called 'Geometry FAP.'

The change to the course titles is in response to the College Board owning the trademark for the term”PAP.” In Fall 2020, The College Board will launch an official PreAP program, and this program focuses more on grade level content rather than the more advanced content. This new information helped many districts across Texas to make the decision to discontinue using the PreAP title.

Faith West Academy will continue to use its own PreAP advanced curriculum as it has historically done. However, the PAP course title names have been changed to more clearly identify and define them as "above grade level courses."
